Supervisors Steve Bennett and Linda Parks have placed the LNG facility on the November 14th Air Pollution Control District agenda. The meeting is at 11:00 in the Board of Supervisors meeting room at the County Government Center (800 S. Victoria Avenue, at the corner of Victoria and Telephone in Ventura).

They are asking the District to oppose the federal governments plan to exempt the LNG facility from meeting all of the air quality standards that any other new source of pollution would have to meet.

With emissions of 200 tons per year, the LNG facility would be Ventura County's largest actual source of NOx and ROC emissions in the county. It is illogical to exempt the facility from new source review standards.
