

## **“Inconvenient Truth” Presenter – Gretchen Lewotsky Bio**

Gretchen Lewotsky, currently VP of State & Local Public Affairs and Environmental Operations for Fox Entertainment Group and been with the studio for over 20 years and has held a variety of positions with a wide range of responsibilities from finance to government relations.

In the late 1980's Gretchen led the drive to green the major Hollywood studios and guided Fox into being the top environmentally conscious studio by developing an environmentally responsible corporate culture. Gretchen has served on Boards of industry-related environmental organizations such as EMA (the Environmental Media Association), and ECO (the Earth Communications Office), as well as local and national organizations such as Heal the Bay, Tree People, and the American Oceans Campaign. In January 2007 Gretchen was chosen by Al Gore's *The Climate Project* to be one of the 1000 persons selected worldwide to be trained by Al Gore to give his *An Inconvenient Truth* slideshow.

In addition to work with the environment, she also represents Fox throughout the community on Boards or in an advisory capacity with organizations dealing with youth and education and the arts.

Gretchen graduated from Pepperdine University with BA's in *Political Science and Economics*, is a graduated from *The Institute of Comparative Political and Economic Systems* at Georgetown University and has certificates from UCLA in *Solid Waste Management; Hazardous Waste Management and Air Quality Management*.
